UIA INFO POINT IN TURIN: ALBERTO GARCIA CASTRO WINNER

An international competition, open to **architects under 35** was organised in the framework of the UIA Congress, Turin 2008 the theme of which it illustrates: **Transmitting architecture**.



The programme concerned the conception of a **UIA information pole in the city of Turin, a place to meet, to relax, a place dedicated to urban democracy**. Of an overall surface of some **100 M2**, the winning project is to be built in Turin for the UIA Congress.

460 projects were submitted to the jury chaired by **George Kunihiro**, Japan, and composed of **Maria Theodorou**, Greece, **Paola Salerno**, Italy, **Reuben Mutiso**, Kenya, **Jennifer Lee**, USA and **Domenico Bagliani**, Italy.

Alberto Garcia Castro, Juan José Cruz, and Ismael Paez Jurado (Spain) won the **first prize** for their project entitled "Paperbox". The jury appreciated **the exercise of transformation** of surfaces into volumes; the ingenuity of the project offering an interior compartmentalisation that replies clearly to the programme, **its strong expression and purity, the judicious choice of materials**.
