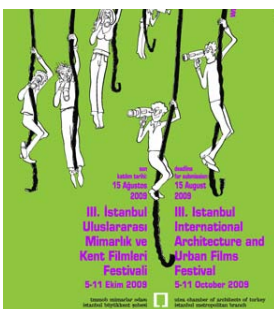
CIP TALKS: ZAGREB

COMMISSION**PROMOTION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE UIA ACCORD**

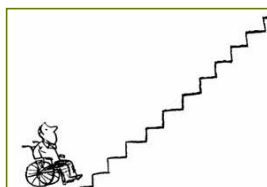
